

RESOLUTION

Whereas, Roger Aceves has a distinguished record of dedicated public service, serving three years as a member of the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors including three years on the Hearing Board Nominating Committee and two years on the South Central Coast Basinwide Control Council; and

Whereas, over the past three years Roger Aceves has participated in the adoption of budgets, rules, and programs that protect and improve the air quality of Santa Barbara County including the Old Car Buyback program and the Clean Air Plan of 2010; and

Whereas, during Roger Aceves' tenure on the APCD Board, numerous grants were approved which funded clean engine replacement programs that reduced the amounts of toxic air contaminants resulting in substantial improvements in air quality for Santa Barbara County; and

Whereas, Roger Aceves has consistently supported the APCD's successful efforts to compel the federal Environmental Protection Agency to promulgate regulations to control the air pollution emitted by ocean-going vessels that traverse the Santa Barbara Channel;

Now, Therefore, it is hereby resolved that the Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors expresses its appreciation to Roger Aceves for his dedication and service on the APCD Board and wishes him well in his future endeavors.
