

RESOLUTION

Whereas, Ashley Costa has served two years on the Board of Directors of the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District, as well as one year as an Alternate Board Member; and

Whereas, over the past two years Ashley Costa has participated in the adoption of budgets, rules, and programs that protect and improve the air quality of Santa Barbara County including Electric Vehicle Charging Station grants and the Old Car Buy Back program; and

Whereas, during Ashley Costa's tenure on the APCD Board, numerous grants were approved which funded clean engine replacement programs that reduced the amounts of toxic air contaminants resulting in substantial improvements in air quality for Santa Barbara County; and

Whereas, Ashley Costa has supported the District's efforts to reduce air pollution emitted by ocean-going vessels that traverse the Santa Barbara Channel, including the 2014 Vessel Speed Reduction trial program which slowed down ships in the Santa Barbara Channel for air pollution reduction and whale-protection benefits.

Now, Therefore, it is hereby resolved that the Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors expresses its appreciation to Ashley Costa for her dedication and service on the APCD Board and wishes her well in her future endeavors.
