# Background – State Clean Air Plan

- Goal
  - To ensure continued progress towards attainment of the state ozone standards
- Santa Barbara County
  - Currently attains federal ozone standard, and state 1hour average ozone standard
  - Does not attain state 8-hour ozone standard
- State plans are updated every 3 years
  - First state Plan adopted by the District Board in 1991
  - 2010 Latest Plan (adopted Jan. 2011)
  - 2013 Plan is sixth triennial update



# Plan Requirements

- Triennial Update Plan required to address attainment of State ozone standard
- Plan fulfills specific Health and Safety Code requirements
  - > Air quality data trends for Ozone
  - Emission reductions achieved
  - Emission inventory and growth forecast
  - Future strategy: stationary source and transportation control measures

- 2. Air Quality Progress
- 3. Emission Inventory and Forecast
- 4. Emission Control Measures/Rules
- 5. Transportation Control Measures

#### Latest Plan Draft

- Originally reviewed by CAC and recommended for Board adoption in May, 2013
- CAC again reviewed Plan in October 2014, made refinements, and recommended for Board adoption
  - No Growth Allowance
  - Updated air quality information
  - Two new TCMs adopted by SBCAG Board



#### Recent Actions

- Updated Board (Oct. 16, 2014) on status and next steps
- CAC recommended Board adoption (Oct. 29, 2014)
- Public Notice (Dec. 14, 2014); review period extended to February 11, 2015
