

California Clean Air Act of 1988

- Attain the ozone standard by the earliest practicable date
- Triennial progress reports:
 - 1991 (initial plan), 1994, 1998, 2001, 2004, 2007, 2010, 2013
- Objectives:
 - 1) Assess the effectiveness of our program
 - 2) Include strategies to obtain further emission reductions



Community Advisory Council and Public Review Process

- Meetings in March, June, and August 2016:
 - Presented draft chapters
 - Discussion, feedback, comments
- CAC comments resulted in numerous revisions
- Public review period September 4 to October 3, 2016
- No comments were received





Recommended Control Measures

- Stationary Source Control Measures:
 - Six measures recommended for adoption (3 NOx, 3 ROC)
 - All these measures have been included in previous plans
- Transportation Control Measures:
 - No change to adopted TCMs and contingency measure
- Continue work to reduce marine shipping emissions



Nonattainment-transitional designation

- Happens by operation of law if a nonattainment area has three or fewer exceedances a year
- Official designation won't happen until early 2017
- What happens if we shift to NA-transitional?



Recommended Board Actions

Adopt the resolution (Attachment 1), which includes:

- CEQA Addendum, with the 2010 Clean Air Plan EIR
- CEQA Findings
- Adopt the 2016 Ozone Plan
- Commitment to adopt proposed control measures
- Commit the District to reviewing the plan and implementation schedule if designation changes to nonattainment-transitional
- Authorize the APCO to transmit the plan to the CA Air Resources Board
