F = Funding

A = Agricultural

R = Replacement

M = Measures for

E = Emission

R = Reductions





How much FARMER funds are available?

- 2018: \$135 million available statewide (Year 1)
- 2019: \$132 million budgeted statewide (Year 2)
- Funds distributed based on district ag equipment inventory
 - 80% of the funds for San Joaquin Valley
 - 0.5% of the funds for Santa Barbara County
- \$583,538 in FY2018-2019 for projects
- \$83,362 for project implementation (administration)





FARMER Project Types


- Carl Moyer Program-Eligible Projects

- Diesel to ZEV Utility Terrain Vehicle Replacement








FARMER Project Areas: AB 1550 Low Income Communities











Project Example: Durant Harvesting [Salvage Inspection]

2018 Clean Air Grant Solicitation

~\$2 million in project funds in Fiscal Year 2018-2019

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    ~30% [~$600,000] FARMER
    ~30% [~$600,000] Carl Moyer
    ~30% [~$600,000] Community Air Protection
    ~5% [~$100,000] Voluntary NOx Remediation Measure
    ~5% [~$100,000] $2 DMV surcharge fee
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- Grants not to exceed \$150,000 or 85% of the total cost, whichever is lower
- First come, first served application process starting mid-September
- Funds need to be secured by executed grant agreement by 6/30/2019
