- Fourth-year of the VSR Program: 2014, 2016, 2017, and 2018
- Asked companies to voluntarily slow down to 10 knots or less
- VSR season (July 1 to November 15) coincides with:
 - Ozone Season; and
 - Whales present off the California Coast



Future of VSR

- Federal Update: Blue Whales and Blue Skies Act (HR3682)
 - Supported by Alan Lowenthal (47th Congressional District)
 - Recognizes voluntary VSR efforts
 - Planned to be reintroduced
- California Update: Ocean Resiliency Act (SB 69)
 - Introduced by Scott Weiner (CA Senate District 11)
 - Includes a state-led program on voluntary VSR
- 2019 VSR Program:
 - Coming soon!
 - Similar level of funding as the 2018 Program
