 - Adopt the California Environmental Quality Act Findings (Attachment 3), including that subsequent environmental review is not required because none of the conditions in CEQA Guidelines section 15162 have occurred;
 - iii. Adopt the 2019 Ozone Plan (Attachment 4); and
 - iv. Authorize the Control Officer to transmit the 2019 Ozone Plan to the California Air Resources Board and do all other acts necessary and proper to obtain approval of the 2019 Ozone Plan.
