California Senate Bill (SB) 1260


- Authored by State Senator Hannah Beth Jackson
- Enacted in September 2018
- Requires CARB-Local Districts Develop and Fund Enhanced Rx Burn Programs including:
 - **1.** Air Quality and Smoke Monitoring
 - 2. Public Awareness Campaigns

RX BURNING – DISTRICT OBJECTIVES

Prevent Smoke From Impacting Communities and Sensitive Receptors

Prevent Exceedances of Federal and State Ambient Air Quality Standards

FIRE & SMOKE- FRIEND & FOE



RX BURNING - ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS

- Prevent Wildfires (Fuels Reduction) and Create Fuel Breaks (Wildland-Urban Interface)
- Mimic Natural Fire Return Intervals
- Control Plant Diseases and Eliminate Invasive Non-Native Plant Species
- Promote Soil Nutrients, Vegetation Growth, and Enhance Livestock Yields
- Protect Watersheds and Improve Ecosystem Health
- Restore Breeding Habitats for Endemic and Threatened Species (e.g., Western Snowy Plover)
- Promote Carbon Sequestration (Soil Regeneration and Photosynthesis)

DISTRICT'S JURISDICTION

- Title 17 California Code of Regulations Section 80102: Provides guidelines and flexibility for Air Districts to develop and implement Smoke Management Programs
- Smoke Management Program and District Rule 401: Provides a structured program for regulating Rx Burning in Santa Barbara County and specifies requirements for Burn Permits, Burn Registration, Smoke Management Plans, Burn Day Determinations, Ignition Authorization, and Burn Reporting





- CARB Burn Day Determinations (Burn, Marginal, No Burn)
- Smoke Management Plans
- Ignition Authorization Requests
- >Burn Reports (Acreage)
- Fire Maps

SMOKE MANAGEMENT PLAN (SMP) – WHAT IS IN IT?

- Location, Contact Information (Land Manager and Landowner)
- Scope of Project (Total Acres, Timeline)
- Specific Plot Number and Location, Specific Plot Ignition Prescription
 - Acres, Cover Type, Tons/Acre, Fuel Arrangement, Fuel Density, Fuel Moisture, Description, Elevations, Slope, Aspect
 - Estimated Emissions and Emission Calculation Method
 - Ignition Prescription (Meteorological Parameters) and Considerations
- Smoke Sensitive Areas, Public Contact Methods (2-Step Media Notification)
- Alternatives to Burning, Smoke Mitigation Measures, SMP Comments, Maps


