STATE PLAN REQUIREMENTS

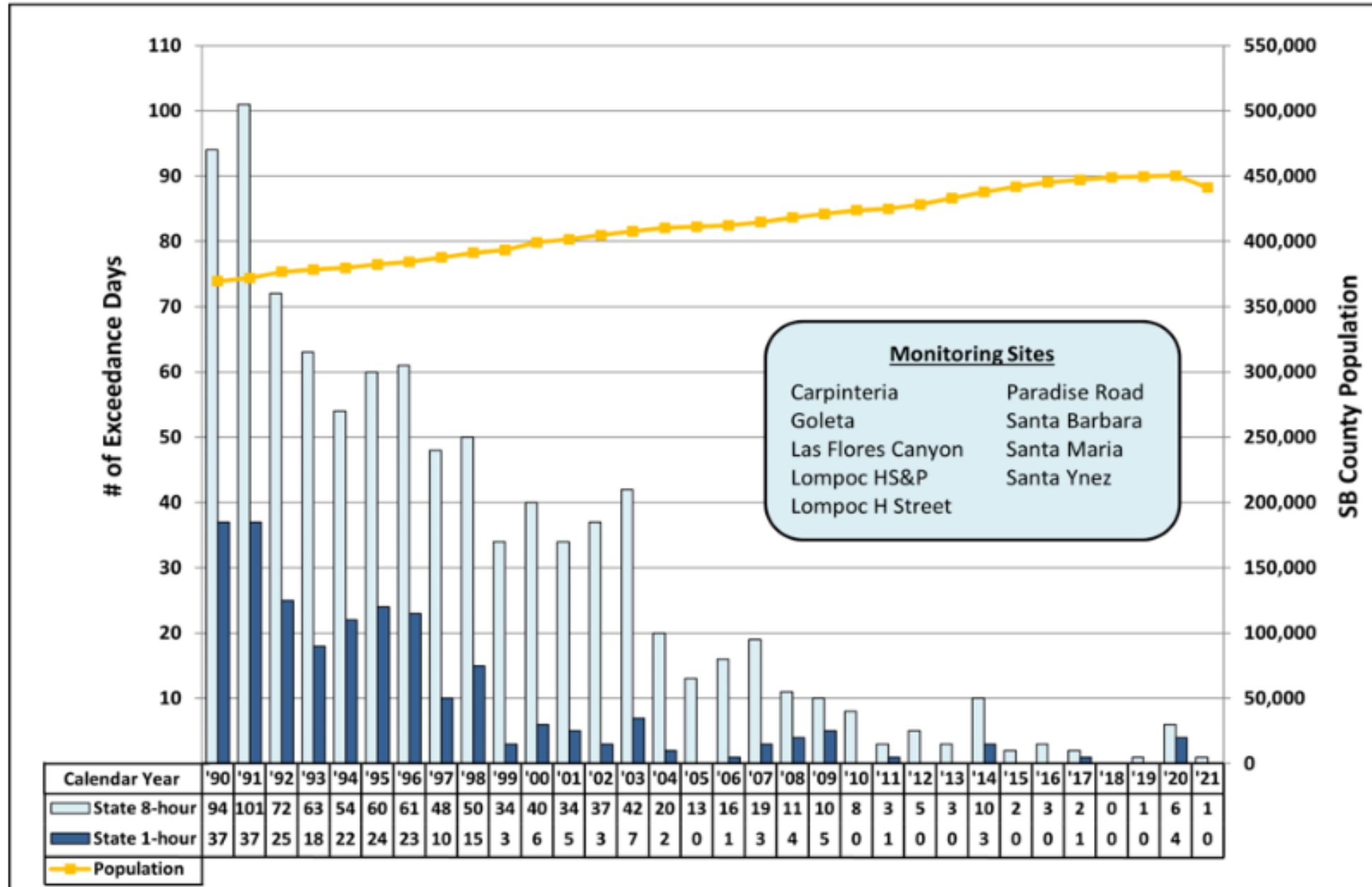
- **California Clean Air Act (1988):**
 - Attain the Ozone standard by the earliest practicable date
- **Original plan adopted in 1991**
- **Triennial progress reports:** 1994, 1998, 2001, 2004, 2007, 2010, 2013, 2016, 2019
- **Objectives:**
 - 1) Assess the effectiveness of our program
 - 2) Evaluate strategies to obtain additional emission reductions

STATE OZONE STANDARDS

Standard	Year Adopted	Ozone Concentration
State 1-Hour Ozone	1988	0.09 ppm
State 8-Hour Ozone	2005	0.070 ppm

Designation Years	Attainment Status
1989 - 2015	Nonattainment
2016 - 2018	Nonattainment-Transitional
2019	Attainment
2020 - 2021	Nonattainment
