

State Ozone Standards - (California Clean Air Act)



Ozone Designations

- Attainment (A): No violations of the standard in the last 3 years.
- Nonattainment (NA): Violations of the standard in the last 3 years.
 - Nonattainment-Transitional (NA-T): 3 or fewer exceedances in the last year.
- A Nonattainment-Transitional designation means:
 - The region is close to attaining the standard, and
 - The District shall review the new control measures in the triennial plan and determine whether they're needed for expeditious attainment.






6/17/2021: Ozone AQI - Contour Maps
