RECITALS

- 1) WHEREAS, state Senate Bill 700 was signed into law in September 2003, came into effect on January 1, 2004, and repealed the permit exemption for all agricultural sources, and
- 2) WHEREAS, state Senate Bill 700 requires that a district designated as an attainment area for the federal ambient air quality standard for ozone adopt a rule or regulation by July 1, 2006, for large confined animal facilities unless a district board makes a determination that large confined animal facilities will not contribute to a violation of any state or federal ambient air quality standard, and
- 3) WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County was designated as an attainment area for the federal eight-hour ozone standard effective June 15, 2004, and
- 4) WHEREAS, the California Air Resources Board adopted a definition of what constitutes a large confined animal facility for various livestock on June 23, 2005, and
- 5) WHEREAS, Air Pollution Control District staff have determined that there are no large confined animal facilities operating in Santa Barbara County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

- 1) The Board hereby determines that there are no large confined animal facilities located in Santa Barbara County.
- 2) The Board hereby determines that there is no need to adopt a rule or regulation for large confined animal facilities under California Health and Safety Code Section 40724.7.
- 3) The Board directs staff to return to the Board with recommendations on how to proceed if it is anticipated that a large confined animal facility will locate in Santa Barbara County at a future date.
