2013 Clean Air Plan

Every three years, the California Clean Air Act requires us to prepare and submit a progress report and plan revision to the *1991 Clean Air Plan*, and document how Santa Barbara County will attain the <u>state</u> ozone standard. The last triennial update, the *2010 Clean Air Plan* for the period 2007 to 2009, was submitted to the California Air Resources Board in January 2011.

In September 2012 we began preparing the 2013 triennial update, which covers the years 2010 to 2012. We briefed the CAC at the October 2012 meeting on the elements that must be addressed in a triennial update, and summarized the proposed content for this 2013 Clean Air Plan. Subsequently the CAC reviewed and provided comments on Chapter 1 (Introduction), Chapter 2 (Local Air Quality) and Chapter 3 (Emission Inventory) at its March 2013 meeting and Chapter 4 (Stationary Source Control Measures) at the February 2013 meeting.

Your CAC package contains the entire draft 2013 Clean Air Plan and consists of Chapters 1 through 4 in strike out-underline format to show the changes made in response to your comments, plus an additional chapter, Chapter 5 (Transportation Control Measures) that you have not seen before. In addition, some emission inventory and emission reduction estimates were revised upon further review (see strike-out underline). Lastly, three appendices (A, B, and C) have been included to supplement Chapter 4.

At the May 8th, 2013 meeting we will be requesting the CAC to pass a motion recommending to the Board of Directors that the Board adopt the 2013 Clean Air Plan. If so recommended, we plan to bring the 2013 Clean Air Plan to the Board at the June 20, 2013 meeting.
