NOAA Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary and Partners: Vessel Speed Reduction Program Results and Ceremony at Sanctuary Advisory Council Meeting

- **What:** Media and the public are invited to learn about results from a 2016 Vessel Speed Reduction (VSR) program that helped to reduce air pollution from ships and protect endangered whales in the Santa Barbara Channel and around the Channel Islands. Representatives from up to 10 shipping lines will be acknowledged and thanked for participating in the novel program, which provides incentives for ships that transit local waters at slower speeds, and that assist with the reporting of whale sightings. The event will occur at a public meeting of the Channel Islands National Marine Sanctuary Advisory Council.
