**Increments**

Q: *When are increment analyses performed?*

A: An increment analysis is performed any time the rules or the District requires modeling or an AQIA to be performed. These analyses are always conducted together.

**Secondary Emissions**

Q: *When are “secondary emissions” taken into account?*

A: Secondary emissions are used when performing an Air Quality Increment Analysis (see Section H). The definition of secondary emissions may be found in Rule 102. Example: A new oil and gas plant is proposed. Along with this construction, a new oil transportation terminal will be installed to move the oil to market. In analyzing the oil and gas plant’s application, the AQIA increment analysis would include the emissions from the new transportation terminal as secondary emissions.
