

RULE 207. DENIAL OF APPLICATIONS. (Adopted 10/18/1971, revised 5/1/1972, readopted 10/23/78)

In the event of denial of an Authority to Construct or Permit to Operate, the Control Officer shall notify the applicant in writing of reasons therefor. Service of this notification may be made in person or by mail, and such service may be proved by the written acknowledgement of the persons served or affidavit of the person making the service. The Control Officer shall not accept a further application unless the applicant has complied with the objections specified by him as his reasons for denial of the Authority to Construct or the Permit to Operate.
